Purchasing Improvements

Enhancement	Retailers can now...
Centralized Purchasing	create a master purchase order at Headquarters from a supplier to be delivered at individual stores.
Landed Cost	automatically calculate the landed cost for each item received through purchase orders and inventory transfers.
Ordering Guidance	gather information when ordering or transferring inventory such as item sales and order history, GMROI (Gross Margin Return On Investment), inventory turns, and profit margin.
Partial Shipment	receive partial shipments and process payments against them.

Voucher Enhancements

Enhancement	Retailers can now...
Global Vouchers	offer their customers the convenience and flexibility to purchase and use vouchers across any store in the chain.
Voucher Usability Improvements	implement automatic voucher numbering, issuing vouchers for store credit, adding funds, and checking balance.
Voucher Accounting	execute accounting treatment of vouchers as liability until redemption.

Reporting

Enhancement	Retailers can now...
GMROI and Inventory Turns Report	view the income on every dollar spent on inventory with GMROI (Gross Margin Return On Investment), which is a key profitability evaluation ratio that analyzes a retailer's ability to turn inventory into cash above the cost of the inventory.
Inventory Valuation Report	track their inventory valuation of their stores, departments, categories, and specific items for a specified date range. In addition, this report can be used for auditing item price, cost, and quantity changes
